- Presentation must be based from a research project.
- Submit synopsis in 300 words or less.
- Film showing is 5-15 minutes.

- 4 Sept. 2019 Full paper (competing paper), poster & short film/audio video documentaries (1-2 min. teaser)

- 24 Sept. 2019 Submission of full short film/documentary
- 25 Sept. 2019 (8:00 A.M.) Posting of research posters
